Have you ever wondered what being on a short-term ministry team would be like? We would like to invite you to join a short-term ministry/medical/dental team that is now planning to spend February 2-15 in Guatemala. This short-term team will include several who went on a short-term ministry/medical/dental team the end of January of this year to Guatemala.

We are planning to go to the Caribbean side of Guatemala. Medical and dental clinics will be held in at least six different communities. There will be planned activities and programs for children. You would spend a night and a day in Punto Gordo,

Belize, along with visiting and having a ministry in communities that are located along the Rio Dulce. The last couple of days that you would be in Guatemala will be spent in Antigua – a fascinating old city with cobblestone streets, where you will have the opportunity to see and to appreciate another area of Guatemala before you return to the U.S.

If you are interested in joining this short-term team, please contact us as soon as possible. I will send you a mockup of the planned trip. The mockup will include the projected budget along with the tentative schedule for the time that this short-term ministry team is in Guatemala. You will have the chance to spend time in a coastal area of Guatemala and then to see extinct and possibly active volcanoes. You will get to see

several sets of different cultures. You will have the chance to interact in a variety of ministry contexts with your host country people. You will probably end up experiencing a sense of transformation in your relationship with your Father God.

I do want to thank you for your prayers as I transition into the position called “pre-field ministries.” In September, Nancy led five new OC missionary candidate units through the Introduction to OC sessions. This is a very intense time for Nancy – as two and a half days is a very short time to share the kind of information that a new missionary candidate would like to have. Nancy will be taking at least two more missionary candidate units through the Introduction to OC sessions this month.
